<i>Pale gold in colour this Sauvignon Blanc displays intense aromas of tropical fruit, complemented with hints of passionfruit &amp; peach</i>	
<b>Pinot Grigio, Italy</b>	<b>£19.50</b>
<i>Elegant, tropical fruit flavour, mellow finish</i>	
<b>Muscadet de Serve et Maine Sur Lie, La Chauviniere</b>	<b>£24.95</b>
<i>Crisp, dry, and herby flavours, clean nutty finish</i>	
<b>Mamaku, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand</b>	<b>£23.95</b>
<i>Citrus, gooseberry flavours with a vibrant acidity and a clean finish.</i>

<i>Dry and crisp, mineral flavours, grass and gooseberry</i>	
<b>Cloudy bay Sauvignon blanc (a real treat)</b>	<b>£45.00</b>
<i>Vibrant &amp; intense, a mouthwatering mix of lemon meringue, ruby grapefruit, lime sherbet &amp; dried pineapple notes that leap out the glass with intense aromatics. A hint of lemon verbena &amp; dried ginger linger on the finish.</i>

<i>Raspberry pink and just a little wild in character this delicious rosé is gently herbal, citrus and refreshing with a squeeze of fresh red cherry on a long finish. Described as being more like a white in character than a typical rosé.</i>

<i>Bramble fruit flavours with a wisp of chocolate a touch of spice onto a fruity finish</i>

<i>smooth full-bodied red wine, flavours of blackcurrant &amp; dark fruits &amp; a hint of spice</i>	
<b>Fleurie, Burgundy, France</b>	<b>£29.50</b>
<i>Very ripe fruit, elegant and floral, spicy nuances</i>	
<b>Pinot Noir, Bouchard Aîné &amp; Fils Bourgogne</b>	<b>£22.95</b>
<i>Exhibiting red fruit aromas including cherry &amp; kirsch with notes of earth and mint. A balanced wine with a lot of fruit and a delicate note of wood. Good persistence. Harmonious and well balanced.</i>	
<b>Adobe Malbec Reserva, Colchagua Valley Chile</b>	<b>£22.95</b>
<i>A deep ruby red with strong aromas of blackberries, mocha, and plums. Flavours are well structured and long lasting, with a palate of cherry and hints of spice and vanilla. One of the best organic Chilean wines around!</i>	
<b>Terrazas Malbec Reserva, Argentina</b>	<b>£29.95</b>
<i>Bright red color with purple shades. Intense floral and fruity notes. Presence of violets, ripe black cherry, and plum aromas. Reveals a toasty and spicy character.</i>	
<b>Concha Y Toro, Casillero Del Diablo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile</b>	<b>£24.95</b>
<i>Dark, ruby red with aromas of cherries, black currant, and dark plums. This Cabernet Sauvignon is very concentrated, rich in flavour, perfectly balanced, and boasts a satisfying and lingering finish.</i>	
<b>Bodegas Artesa Rioja, Spain</b>	<b>£24.95</b>
<i>Medium bodied tempranillo aged in American oak, fine balance of fruit and tannin</i>	
<b>La Fluer Saint Georges, Lalande de Pomerol 2014, France</b>	<b>£39.95</b>
<i>Deep red with silky tannins, flavours of red fruits, delicate spices</i>	
<b>Folonari Valpolicella Classisco, Italy</b>	<b>£21.50</b>
<i>Classic red wine of Italy's Veneto region; a blend of local grape varieties that combine to give forward fruit and a supple approachable structure. Ruby red in colour, with upfront spice and plum aromas.</i>
