Champagne & Sparkling

1. Prosecco Belstar £31

The elegant flavour and fruity and floral bouquet is the essence of Belstar Prosecco

2. Signat Cava, Pinot Noir Rosado £28

Presents aromas of red wild forest fruits (strawberries, raspberries) and very elegant.

3. Moët & Chandon, Brut Champagne NV £67

The Moët & Chandon Brut NV is characterized by bright fruitiness and elegant maturity.

4. Moët & Chandon Rose, Champagne NV £77

The aromas are intense and irresistible, a lively bouquet of fresh red summer berries (strawberry, raspberry and red currant) with floral nuances (rose, hawthorn) and a light peppery touch.

5. Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rose Brut, Champagne, France, NV £115

It is characterized by its ripe red fruit aromas, a high intensity and great freshness.

6. Ruinart, Blanc de Blancs, Champagne, France £112

At first very intense on the nose, with fresh fruit notes, particularly ripe citrus fruits. At second refined floral nose with notes of white flowers and fruits (white peaches, pineapple).

7. Forget-Brimont, Brut, Premier Cru £45

Its white fruits and lively feel are allied to a creamy texture to produce a Champagne that is ready to drink now.

8. Dom Perignon Brut, Champagne France 2010 £210

Its class and elegance make it welcome at any table. Savour its complex, lively palate, rich in white fruit fragrances. Discover its floral, vegetal and spicy nuances.

9. Moët & Chandon, Garden Spritz £48

Ready to chill and ready to share, Garden Spritz is the blend of an exceptional sparkling wine and a unique bitters recipe crafted with locally sourced fresh oranges macerated with dry orange peels, herbs and spices carefully selected from the finest terroirs in the world. We bring nature to the world of spritz.

French White

10. Chateau Puyfromage, 2018 £34

Light yellow with green tints. Expressive nose of citrus fruits and blackcurrant leaf. The palate is light and shows vibrant, lively, crisp fruit aromatics. A distinctive, balanced wine

11. Petit Chablis Vibrant, La Chablisienne 2020 £36

Aromas of ripe apple and pear with a hint of peach.

It has a persistent savoury and refreshing finish

12. Chablis Domaine Jean Defaix 2018 £49

Crisp green apple, lemon, pear, quince, chalk, and wet stone rise up from the glass.

The palate is bright with lovely finesse in the finish.

13. Pouilly Fuisse Doudet Naudin £67

Elegantly reveals its aromas of white flowers and white flesh fruits (Mirabelle peach) and some nuances of exotic fruits developing after opening

14. Chassagne Montrachet, Maisson Remoissenet 2016 £98

The delicate nose is marked by aromas of flowers such as linden blossom and acacia.

The finish is persistent and generous, yet maintains its freshness.

15. Domaine Vincent Latour Bourgogne Blanc 2017 £51

An attractive nose of citrus, floral and white fleshed fruit aromas leads to appealingly rich, round and well-delineated flavours that culminate in a clean, dry and ever so- mildly austere finish.

16. Meursault-Blagny, 1er Cru, Chateau de Blagny, Louis Latour 2017 £70

With a pale yellow color, our Meursault 1er Cru "Château de Blagny" 2017 reveals an intense bouquet of exotic fruits and peach

17. Macon Villages Reserve Vignerons des Terres Secretes 2018 £29

This is a clear and bright wine with aromas of white flowers, citrus, and yellow fruits.

18. Muscadet Sevre et Maine sur Lie Les Templiers £28

Lovely and light with aromas and flavours of apples, pears, peaches and figs. The texture has a delicate spritz and the finish is long.

19. Vouvray, Demi-Sec, 'La Forcine' 2020/21 £28

A hint of apple on the nose, round and succulent, offset by elegant citrus flavours, this rich, demi-sec style.

20. Pouilly-Fumé de Ladoucette 2016 £58

The delicate and complex olfactory expression opens on aromas which remind of white flower, exotic fruits.

21. Menetou-Salon, 'Les Thureaux', Joseph Mellot 2019/20 £43

Bright light golden colour. Pure and aromatic nose displaying elderflower, fresh stone fruit, ripe citrus and some stony notes.

22. Domaine du Pre Semele, Sancerre, Loire £44

A classic Sancerre with crisp, crunchy grapefruit and lime citrus flavours and a gently herbaceous element adding complexity.

23. Viognier Ardecche Louis Latour £30

Of a brilliant pale gold colour, the Ardèche Viognier 2020 offers an intense nose of juicy apricot.

24. Picpoul de Pinet, Coteaux du Languedoc, Terre d'Eole 2020/21 £25

Fresh, light and refreshing with citrus and lemongrass flavours. The perfect lighter dry white with or without food.

French Red

25. Ch. Clos De La Cure, Grand Cru, St. Emillion 2014 £60

An excellent Saint Emilion Grand Cru. Clos de la Cure Saint Emilion Grand Cru has enticing aromas of soft plummy fruit, lovely weight in the mouth and a smooth lingering finish.

26. Chateau Senejac, Haut-Medoc, 2016 £49

Dark red and blue fruits with leafy notes, fine tannins and subtle oak. Will age extremely well.

27. Chateau Cazau Martet Organic Bordeaux Rouge 2016 £30

Expect aromas of fresh red strawberry, raspberry, redcurrant fruit and a faint note of lavender.

28. Chateau Lucas, Lussac, St. Emilion 2015 £41

A dense meaty nose, with liquorice and fennel, followed by cedar and black fruits. This rich, chunky style with dense plummy fruit, spice, cedar and ripe tannins. (Merlot/Cab Franc.)

29. Beaujolais-Villages, Henry Fessy 2020/21 £28

The nose is full of red fruits, lightly spicy. In the mouth, the structure is round and supple with ripe black fruits flavours.

30. Bourgogne Pinot Noir Louis Latour £38

Ample and powerful on tasting, this wine expresses an interesting aromatic complexity, coated in soft tannins. Blueberry and coffee aromas still linger and offer an elegant and enjoyable finish.

31. Fleurie, Georges Duboeuf, 2017 £33

The Fleurie has an intense crimson colour and reveals a range of fruity and floral aromas: iris, violets, roses, red berries and wild peaches.

32. Cotes du Rhone Bassot Rouge £28

Deep in colour and relatively soft and rounded after the initial vibrant redcurrant and somewhat spicy nose.

33. La Bastide Saint Dominique Chateauneuf-du-Pape 2016 £65

The wine is polished, opulent and serves up a long, ripe, fruit filled finish with density, polish and length. This is a really strong wine for the vintage.

34. Chateau Vieux Cardinal Lafaurie, Lalande de Pomerol 2018 £48

A bold, smoky and generous wine, this shows perfumed wood-aging flavors as well as ripe blackberry fruits. Dominated by Merlot, but with a good proportion of Cabernet Franc, the wine should age well. Drink from 2022.

35. Chateau Gloria, St. Julien 2017 £88

An attractive, immediately fruity wine, this also has good tannins. Enticing blackberry flavours give richness as well as freshness.

36. Chateau Beau-Site, St. Estephe, Cru Bourgeois Superieur 2017 £52

Notes of bilberry, spice and hints of cigar continue on the palate which is enveloped in smooth, ripe tannins. This wine shows lovely balance, depth and structure with an elegantly spiced finish.

37. Margaux d'Origins, Margaux, Borie Manoux 2019 £59

Deep garnet colour. Nose with grilled character. Fruity (blackberries), woody and brioche notes. Powerful structure on the finish. BLEND 2019 : 65 % Merlot, 35 % Cabernet-Sauvignon.

Spain, Portugal White & Red

38. Albarino Domingo Martin £34

Rich and generous flavours of ripe peaches and pears, backed by vivid lemon and mineral acidity. A well-balanced wine with a fresh finish.

39. Blanco, Seco, Marques de Caceres, Rioja, Spain 2019/21 £25

On the nose, mineral notes and floral sensations with a depth of green apples. Refreshing and balanced in the mouth with a pleasant, long-lasting acidity that adds a touch of zest to the finish.

40. Crianza, Cellar Cal Pla, Priorat, Spain 2018/19 £34

Expressive, juicy and bright with lots of dark berries, red cherries and plums. There is depth too with toasty, spice and pepper notes making this extraordinarily good value.

41. Monte Clavijo Rioja Tempranillo Tinto Joven £27.50

A dense meaty nose, with liquorice and fennel, followed by cedar and black fruits. This rich, chunky style with dense plummy fruit, spice, cedar and ripe tannins. (Merlot/Cab Franc.)

42. Planalto, Reserva Branco, Casa Ferreirinha, Douro, Portugal 2020 £23

A super-reliable crowd pleaser, this is a fresh, dry Portuguese white from high-altitude vineyards which bring freshness to the resulting wine.

43. Esteva, Casa Ferreirinha, Douro, Portugal 2019/20 £26

The wine shows fine aromatic intensity, with stand-out notes of red fruits, floral notes of rock rose and slightly mentholated balsamic aromas, such as heather. The red fruit notes and a floral touch appear again in the mouth.

Italy White & Red

44. Conti Serristori Chianti DOCG £28

The 2015 Conti Serristori Chianti Classico has a garnet hue, with fresh aromas of red fruits & berries, cherry liquor and a hint of toasted almond. Dry, rustic and earthy notes with red fruits and berries, soft tannins, medium acidity and lingering finish. Great wine for every day consumption.

45. Rocca di Frassinello Rigogolo 2016 £33

Combining strength, intensity and elegance, with soft tannins to give it a roundness in the mouth. Fruity nose with a sweet spiciness. Lively and balanced.

46. Folonari Montepulciano d'Abbruzzo £24

The dry, round, warm palate is velvety and firm, with a long, lingering, delightful finale of dried fruit and toasted hazelnut.

47. Fontanafredda Barolo DOCG Piedmont, Italy 2015 £70

lean, full and intense nose, with typical traces of withered flowers, dry leaves and underbrush. Robust and well-bodied, with acidity and firm tannins.

48. Pinot Grigio, Il Tempo Passa £23

It's rich and creamy, and the taste of white peaches and white grapes fans out over the finish

49. Tenimenti Ca' Bianca Gavi di Gavi £32

The wine is fermented in stainless steel and aged briefly on its fine lees. It shows white flower and green fruit aromas, with a touch of honey and minerality on the palate.

50. Grillo, Rupe Secca 2020/21 £24

Grillo is the result of a crossing between Catarratto and Moscato di Alessandria grapes and, produces crisp and delightful wines. Aromatic nose of citrus and tropical fruit. Easy drinking with a refreshing acidity. Perfect for Summer.

Germany

51. Villa Wolf, Riesling, Rheinland-Pfalz, 2018 £32

Hints of smoke and pine fronds accent crisp grapefruit and lime flavors in this focused dry Riesling. Medium bodied and briskly concentrated, it finishes on a firm grip of fine tannins and a crush of earthen minerality. Best enjoyed young.

South Africa White & Red

52. Journeys End Chardonnay £29

Clear and bright, straw with a hint of green. Expressive fruit, initially lemon and citrus, but under that, it's more tropical and pineapple, all seamed through with crushed almond, savoury oak tones.

53. Sauvignon Blanc, Kingklip Bay, Western Cape 2021/22 £25

This Sauvignon Blanc from the Western Cape displays fresh, ripe yellow fruit flavours with a hint of waxy lime, as well as some leafy herbal notes which make for a zippy, racy and deeply quaffable drop.

54. Cotte Chenin Blanc, 'LMill', Franschoek Cellar, Western Cape 2021

£27

The dry, round, warm palate is velvety and firm, with a long, lingering, delightful finale of dried fruit and toasted hazelnut.

55. 'Lanoy', Cabernet-Sauvignon/Merlot, Boschendal Estate, Western Cape 2018/20 £32

A burst of rich dark red mulberry, blackcurrant, ripe plum and spice aromas that carries through to a smooth, juicy entry supported by ripe tannins and just discernible cigar box spiciness.

56. Franschoek Shiraz (Baker Station) £26

This well-structured Shiraz has exuberant mulberry, plum, pepper and spice are balanced by soft, ripe tannins for a finish with length and finesse.

57. Boschendal Sommelier Selection Pinotage £36

Rich, ripe and vibrant red and black currants, spice and plumbs. A classic example of South Africa's very own grape varietal.

North and South America White & Red

58. Sauvignon Blanc, Camino de la Cabana, Central Valley, Chile £23

In the palate is crisp, round, refreshing and with a persistent texture.

59. Chardonnay, Lodi, Ironstone Vineyards, California, USA £29

Offers refreshing aromas of fresh green apples, citrus, and tropical fruits. On the palate, there is light citrus layered with fresh peaches.

60. Malbec Reserva Adobe £26

Medium-bodied on the palate with silky ripe tannins and a long, broad finish.

61. Merlot Reserva Adobe £23

Ruby coloured; moderate aromas of cassis, chocolate and smoke with floral and toasty notes; extra dry and medium bodied; flavours of rich cassis and a spicy, savoury finish.

**62. Carmenere, Reserva, Hacienda Araucano, Colchagua Valley, Chile
£30**

Concentrated nose of liquorice and blackcurrant, with a minty freshness. Exceptionally round and soft on the palate. Slight grilled notes of coffee come through on the finish

**63. Cabernet-Sauvignon, Reserve, Patria Nueva, Curico Valley, Chile
2019/20 £28**

A juicy and round on the palate with firm tannins that combine well with dark fruits, prunes and roasted nuts with toasty finish

64. Tannat, Finca Traversa, Montevideo, Uruguay 2019/21 £27

This wine is a blend of 50% Tannat and 50% Merlot. An intense red colour with violet tones.

65. Norman Hardie Pinot Noir £49

The palate is ripe and loaded with flavours of red cherry, strawberry and classic beetroot with a long, lingering finish.

**66. Old Vine Zinfandel, Lodi, Ironstone Vineyards, California, USA
2018/19 £33**

Great structure with fruity and barrel aging flavours followed by a lingering aftertaste

Australia & New Zealand White & Red

67. Woolloomoollooooo Shiraz, Australia £23

A superb value wine which shows all the classic black fruit flavour and full body of an Aussie Shiraz along with the peppery, spicy complexity of its French counterparts.

68. Letfield Albarino, New Zealand £36

n aromatic upstart that will duel for your affection with juicy peach and melon flavours to be so more than your holiday romance.

69. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc £63

Is intense and vibrant. The nose is open, appealing and expressive, with ripe passionfruit, white peach and a hint of lime

70. Southern Rivers Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough £27.50

A fresh, grassy-gooseberry Sauvignon Blanc from the East Coast region, Cool-fermented in stainless steel and bottled early to maintain the freshness and fruit.

71. Pinot Gris, 'Silver Series', Tempus Two, Australia 2021/22 £24

This wine is a pale lemon colour. Fresh and vibrant wine. On the nose crisp and refreshing characters of pear and passionfruit with floral undertones. On the nose there is a delicate aroma of pear and passionfruit with floral undertones.

72. Chardonnay, 'Altitude', Nepenthe, Adelaide Hills, Australia 2020/21 £29

Lifted notes of white peach and sweet spice. Stone fruit flavours dominate the palate with hints of sweet spice from French oak.

73. Sauvignon Blanc, Reserve, Wairau Valley, Villa Maria, New Zealand £38

The wine displays powerful aromas of blackcurrant, boxwood and grapefruit. The palate has an enticing array of ripe tropical fruits mixed with dried herbs such as rosemary, finishing with fresh zesty acidity.

74. Pinot Noir, Spy Valley, Marlborough, New Zealand 2019 £45

Aromas of berry fruits, clove and aniseed spices create an enticing aromatic blend. Sweet fruit on the palate provides layers of suppleness and an elegant structure with fine rounded tannins.

75. Merlot, 'Silver Series', Tempus Two, Australia 2020/21 £23

full-bodied, voluptuous wine with fine tannins and ripe, berry fruit flavours balanced by earthiness and spice. Subtle oak characters give complexity and enhance the rich, yet smooth and typically merlot palate.

76. Rag and Bone, Riesling, 2019 £38

it's like a fresh lime crushed gently over minerals... literally lime on the rocks. The palate is bright and zingy, singing with natural acidity and vibrant citrus and floral characters.

77. Lou Miranda, 120yr old vine Shiraz, Barossa, 2012 £90

A seductive wine displaying great palate weight, length and structure. Rich fruit characters are complemented by oak spice and ripe tannins. Lingering cherry and mocha on the wines after taste ensure the wine amazing length and persistence on the palate.

Rose Wines

78. Ultimate Provence, Cotes de Provence, France 2020/21 £51

Layers of raspberry, strawberry jam in the nose invite you to a gorgeous, yet spicy palate. A fresh wine with great acidity for food pairing, but roundness to enjoy on its own. If you only have one bottle to bring – this is the ultimate wine for any occasion.

79. Diamarine, Coteaux Varois en Provence, France 2020/21 £27.50

Pale pink, very expressive on the nose. Deliciously tangy on the palate with fresh fruit and citrus peel aromas leading to a very elegant finish.

80. Sancerre Rose, Domaine du Pre Semele, France 2020/21 £39.50

A classic Sancerre with crisp, crunchy grapefruit and lime citrus flavours and a gently herbaceous element adding complexity. There is a mouth-watering, saline minerality to the long finish. Just brilliant.

81. Pinot Grigio, Rose, Il Tempo Passa 2020/21 £23

This lovely rosé is produced from ripe Pinot Grigio grapes and a small proportion of red Pinot Noir grapes, which ensure its beautiful colour and soft red fruit flavours.

Dessert Wine

82. Boschendal Noble Late Harvest, Stellenbosch £27

This natural sweet wine presents loads of citrus aromas, especially tangerine, hints of tropical fruit and delicate honeysuckle. On the palate it has a tremendous concentration of fruit at the core and a good balance.

83. Montes Late Harvest Botrytised Gewurztraminer, Chile 75ml £7

his sweet wine has a deep, bright-golden colour. Potent, complex nose with clear notes of honey, ripe cherries and sultana raisins all mingled with intriguing chamomile flower aromas. The palate has great volume and an attractive acidity that lingers on the finish

84. Stanley Estate's Noble Harvest Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 75ml £7

This ultra-tangy, treat that oozes passionfruit and lemon curd, honeysuckle and toffee notes

85. Royal Tokaji Late Harvest, 2017, Hungary £35

Pale gold colour with delicate citrus and spicy aromas. Light and refreshing on the palate with hints of white peach and honey. It has an excellent acid balance, a smooth, silky texture and a clean, long, crisp finish.

86. Riesling Ice-wine Stratus 2017/18 £36

This perfumed, floral-scented white boasts apricot, apple and orange peel flavours. Elegant, pure and vibrant, with a mouth-watering finish

87. Pellegrino Marsala Superiore Garibaldi Dolce £33

A sweet, fruity Marsala wine from Pellegrino that pairs wonderfully with Tiramisu.
