————— **SPARKLING WINE BY THE BOTTLE** —————

1. PROSECCO

£33

Elegant flavor, fruity and floral bouquet.

3. VEUVE CLICQUOT, BRUT – YELLOW LABEL

£86

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label manages to reconcile two opposing factors - strength and silkiness - and to hold them in perfect balance with aromatic intensity and a lot of freshness. Notes of yellow and white fruits, lemon zest and vanilla.

4. DOM PERIGNON BRUT, CHAMPAGNE FRANCE 2010

£280

Its class and elegance make it welcome at any table. Savour its complex, lively palate, rich in white fruit fragrances. Discover its floral, vegetal and spicy nuances.

6. RUINART - BLANC DES BLANCS, BRUT

£112

At first very intense on the nose, with fresh fruit notes, particularly ripe citrus fruits. At second refined floral nose with notes of white flowers and fruits (white peaches, pineapple)

7. BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE

£98

Fine bubble Champagne. The nose is aromatic and complex with ripe fruit and spicy aromas. Roasted apples, apple compote and peaches burst on the palate. Brioche and notes of fresh walnut linger on the lasting finish. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity.



FRENCH WHITE

- 11. MUSCADET, SEVRE ET MAINE SUR LIE LES TEMPLIERS** £29
Lovely and light with aromas and flavors of apples, pears, peaches and figs. The texture has a delicate spritz and the finish is long.
- 13. CHABLIS, DOMAINE JEAN DEFAIX 2018** £61.50
Crisp green apple, lemon, pear, quince, chalk, and wet stone rise up from the glass. The palate is bright with lovely finesse in the finish.
- 14. PETIT-CHABLIS, LA CHABLISIENNE 2020** £54
Aromas of ripe apple and pear with a hint of peach. Refreshing finish.
- 15. MACON-LUGNY, LES GENIEVRES, 2019/2020** £45
Pale yellow colour wine, with floral and peach aromas, that result in a full-body wine with a round finish.
- 16. RIESLING, GRAND CRU, SOMMERBERG JEAN BIECHER & SCHAAL** £53
The wine structure is full-bodied and ample, backed with robust exuberance. Gypsum is expressed by specific and delicate minerality, through smoky, matchstick and flint notes.
- 18. SANCERRE, DOMAINE DU PRE SEMELE, LOIRE** £48
A classic Sancerre with crisp, crunchy grapefruit and lime citrus flavors and a gently herbaceous element adding complexity.
- 19. PICPOUL DE PINET, COTEAUX DU LANGUEDOC. 2020/ 2021** £27.50
Fresh, light and refreshing with citrus and lemongrass flavors. The perfect lighter dry white with or without food. Vineyards which bring freshness to the resulting wine.
- 22. MACON-VILLAGES, RESERVE, 2018** £42.50
Clean and vibrant unoaked Chardonnay. This wine shows floral, apple and citrus aromas with fresh, clean flavors and mineral notes. Perfect as an aperitif or with shellfish, crab cakes or goat cheese.
- 24. MEURSAULT-BLAGNY - 1ER CRU, CHATEAU DE BLAGNY, LOUIS LATOUR 2017** £90
With a pale yellow color, our Meursault 1er Cru "Château de Blagny" 2017 reveals an intense bouquet of exotic fruits and peach
- 26. POUILLY-FUISSE, 2018 (FR)** £67
This wine has aromas of fresh red apples, honey and white flowers with elegant and rich flavors of toasted nuts and citrus. One of the purest expressions of this typical Burgundian grape.



FRENCH RED

- 32. COTES DU RHONE, BASSOT ROUGE** £28.50
Deep in colour and relatively soft and rounded after the initial vibrant redcurrant and somewhat spicy nose.
- 37. BEAUJOLAIS-VILLAGES, HENRY FESSY 2020/21** £28
The nose is full of red fruits, lightly spicy. In the mouth, the structure is round and supple with ripe black fruits flavours.
- 39. PINOT NOIR, LOUIS LATOUR, BOURGOGNE, 2020** £53.50
Ample and powerful on tasting, this wine expresses an interesting aromatic complexity, coated in soft tannins. Blueberry and coffee aromas still linger and offer an elegant and enjoyable finish.
- 40. BORDEAUX ROUGE, CHATEAU CAZAU MARTET, ORGANIC, 2016** £34
Expect aromas of fresh red strawberry, raspberry, redcurrant fruit and a faint note of lavender.
- 42. ST. EMILLION, CH. CLOS DE LA CURE, GRAND CRU, 2016** £69.50
An excellent Saint Emilion Grand Cru. Clos de la Cure Saint Emilion Grand Cru has enticing aromas of soft plummy fruit, lovely weight in the mouth and a smooth lingering finish.
- 43. CRU BOURGEOIS SUPERIEUR, CHATEAU BEAU-SITE, ST. ESTEPHE, 2017** £71
Notes of bilberry, spice and hints of cigar continue the palate which is enveloped in smooth, ripe tannins. This wine shows lovely balance, depth and structure with an elegantly spiced finish.
- 44. MARGAUX D'ORIGINS, MARGAUX, BORIE MANOUX, 2019** £59
*Deep garnet color. Nose with grilled character. Fruity (blackberries), woody and brioche notes. Powerful structure on the finish.
BLEND 2019 : 65 % Merlot, 35 % Cabernet- Sauvignon.*



— ROSE WINE —

46. PINOT GRIGIO ROSE, IL TEMPO PASSA

£24

This lovely rosé is produced from ripe Pinot Grigio grapes and a small proportion of red Pinot Noir grapes, which ensure its beautiful color and soft red fruit flavors.

47. DIAMARINE, COTEAUX VAROIS EN PROVENCE, 2020/21

£31

Pale pink, very expressive on the nose. Deliciously tangy on the palate with fresh fruit and citrus peel aromas leading to a very elegant finish.

48. ZINFANDEL, RIPTIDE, 2020

£24.50

White Zinfandel is semi-dry too sweet with fresh flavors of red berry, citrus and melon, along with just a whisper of nutmeg and clove zestiness.

49. SANCERRE ROSE, DOMAINE DU PRE SEMELE, LOIRE

£46.50

A classic Sancerre with crisp, crunchy grapefruit and lime citrus flavors and a gently herbaceous element adding complexity.

There is a mouth-watering, saline minerality to the long finish.

Just brilliant.

50. ULTIMATE PROVINCE 2020/2021

£63

Bright, even, pale peach-pink. The wine has an enticing bouquet, red and white blossom interweave red berries, nectarine, citrus zest and a hint of white pepper. Medium-bodied, dry to taste, excellent intensity flavours of red berries, nectarine melded with grapefruit zest, red floral and white pepper linger to a long, refreshing finish.



————— **SPAIN & PORTUGAL** —————
WHITE & RED

- 20. ALBARINO, DOMINGO MARTIN** £36.50
Rich and generous flavours of ripe peaches and pears, backed by vivid lemon and mineral acidity. A well-balanced wine with a fresh finish.
- 21. PLANALTO, CASA FERREIRINHA, DOURO, 2020** £27
A super-reliable crowd pleaser; this is a fresh, dry Portuguese white from high- altitude.
- 28. RIOJA, CASTILLO CLAVIJO, 2021/2022** £29
Intense black cherry notes, accompanied by sweet vanilla fragrance. It is smooth and elegantly balanced, with a delicious and lingering aftertaste.

————— **ITALY** —————
WHITE & RED

- 8. PINOT GRIGIO, IL TEMPO PASSA** £24
It's rich and creamy, and the taste of white peaches and white grapes fans comes out over the finish.
- 23. GAVI DI GAVI, TENIMENTI CA' BIANCA** £33.50
The wine is fermented in stainless steel and aged briefly on its fine lees. It shows white flower and green fruit aromas, with a touch of honey and minerality on the palate.
- 25. FRASCATI SUPERIOR, SANTA TERESA** £28
Frascati wines feature their own distinctive and delicate flavour profile of white peaches and blanched almonds, and an outdoorsy scent of wildflowers and hay. Incredibly light and fresh will give you a taste of Rome in a sip.
- 36. MONTEPULCIANO D'ABBRUZZO, FOLONARI** £26
The dry, round, warm palate is velvety and firm, with a long, lingering, delightful finale of dried fruit and toasted hazelnut.
- 38. CHIANTI CLASSICO, SAN JACOPO, 2019** £38.50
*Dry, rustic and earthy notes with red fruits and berries, soft tannins, medium acidity and lingering finish.
Great wine for everyday consumption.*



————— **SOUTH AFRICA** —————
WHITE & RED

- 27. CHENIN BLANC, BUSH VINES** £28
Minerally floral wine, with flavors of quince and hints of dried fruit and toasted hazelnuts.
- 34. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CONCHA Y TORO, CHILE** £25
100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Central Valley of Chile. Bright and intense ruby red, with violet reflections. The nose delivers fresh red fruits, together notes of coffee and chocolate. Harmonic tannins, medium-bodied.

————— **NORTH & SOUTH AMERICA** —————
RED

- 29. MERLOT RESERVA, ADOBE ORGANIC 2018** £28
Ruby colored; moderate aromas of cassis, chocolate and smoke with floral and toasty notes; extra dry and medium bodied; flavors of rich cassis and a spicy, savoury finish.
- 30. MALBEC RESERVA, TRIVENTO 2021** £30
Sweet dark berries on the palate with silky ripe tannins and a long, broad finish.
- 33. CABERNET-SAUVIGNON, RESERVA, PATRIA NUEVA** £32
A juicy and round on the palate with firm tannins that combine well with dark fruits, prunes and roasted nuts with toasty finish
- 45. CARMENERE - RESERVA, HACIENDA ARAUCANO** £34.50
Concentrated notes of liquorice and blackcurrant, with a minty freshness. Round and soft on the palate with notes of coffee on the finish.



———— AUSTRALIA & NEW ZEALAND ————
WHITE & RED

9. SAUVIGNON BLANC, MIRROR LAKE £30

Refreshing and citrus wine with a light hint of gooseberries.

10. SAUVIGNON BLANC, CLOUDY BAY £73.50

Is intense and vibrant. The nose is open, appealing and expressive, with ripe passionfruit, white peach and a hint of lime.

12. CHARDONNAY, EXMOOR, XANADU 2019 £35.50

This Chardonnay displays honeydew melon, pear, and citrus characters with underlying hints of loquats and hay. Oak is merely a bystander, yet its subtle influence adds another layer to the fruity aromas.

The palate is medium bodied offering gala apples and stone fruits with a delicate creamy texture derived from lees stirring.

35. SHIRAZ, WOOLLOOMOOLLOOOO £24.50

A superb value wine which shows all the classic black fruit flavour and full body of an Aussie Shiraz along with the peppery, spicy complexity of its French counterparts.



— **DESSERT WINE** —

52. ROYAL TOKAJI LATE HARVEST, 2017

£45

Pale gold colour with delicate citrus and spicy aromas. Light and refreshing on the palate with hints of white peach and honey. It has an excellent acid balance, a smooth, silky texture and a clean, long, crisp finish.

53. SAUTERNE, CHATEAU GRAVAS, 2009

£45

Tasting notes of this Sauterne include apricot, honey, peaches, ginger, tropical fruit, honeysuckle, butterscotch, and toasted baking spices. Fresh acidity to balance out the sweetness of this dessert wine in addition to a decent amount of alcohol makes it delightfully complex.

54. BOSCHENDALL, VIN D'OR, 2008

£36

This natural sweet wine presents loads of citrus aromas, especially tangerine, hints of tropical fruit and delicate honeysuckle. On the palate it has a tremendous concentration of fruit at the core and a good balance.

55. MUSCAT DE RIVESALTES LAFAGE, 2020

£32.50

The Muscat Blancs have a range of floral, citrus and spice aromas. In this case expect notes of lemon, pear or sometimes peach orange blossom and lychees.
